The DIS Telecommunications Services Division is pleased to announce a new optional-use master contract for computer equipment, peripherals, and related services with Fujitsu America, Inc. The current scope for this master contract is:

- Band 1 – Servers
- Band 2 – Workstations
- Band 4 – Storage Solutions
- Operating Systems
- Local Area Network Devices

This master contract is available for use by state, local, and tribal government organizations; and certain publicly funded non-profit groups.

This new contract satisfies mandatory state government procurement requirements. (Please note that non-state government organizations may have different procurement regulations.)

The optional-use designation means that purchasers may buy computer equipment from other vendors, provided that applicable acquisition requirements have been satisfied.

Listed below is important information regarding master contracts—including the new Fujitsu America, Inc. contract—for computer equipment, peripherals, and related services:

- The purchaser must have an active Interlocal or Customer Service Agreement (CSA) with DIS to use this master contract.
- Please note: Only items on the vendor's published Products and Services Schedule for the Western States Contracting Alliance are available for purchase.
